



**Frequently Asked Questions**

**Q1** When is the lavender in bloom?

**A** Blooming season for lavender will depend on the variety of lavender, but usually the early blooms begin in late June. In Furano, peak season is mid July, and late blooming lavender reaches peak season in early August. Once August arrives, some fields begin to cut back the lavender to preserve the roots. Please check for updates on blooming conditions on the Furano Tourism Association website.

**Q2** Where should I get off in order to go to Farm Tomita?

**A** The closest station to Farm Tomita is Lavender-Farm Station. Lavender-Farm Station is available to use from June 9 to September 24. For other periods, Naka-Furano Station will be the closest station. It is 25 minutes' walk from Naka-Furano Station.

**Q3** Which trains stop at the Lavender Farm Station?

**A**

- ① Rapid Furano Biei Train: Stops on June 30-August 12
- ② Furano Biei Norokko Train: Stops during operating periods
- ③ Some local trains: Stop on July 13-16
