JR Hokkaido and JR East are launching the JR Tohoku-South Hokkaido Rail Pass, a discount pass for travel in the areas of both companies allowing foreign visitors to Japan to have fun traveling in a wider area. This product can be used on trains including the Shinkansen and Limited Express trains in the Tohoku and South Hokkaido areas, including Sapporo, Hakodate, and the New Chitose Airport.

In the future, JR Hokkaido and JR East will make further efforts to promote wide-area sightseeing routes together with local regions to offer more enjoyable travel to more foreign customers.

- ◇Sales period           Friday, January 5, 2018 to Sunday, March 31, 2019

- ◇Validity period        Any five days of your choice during the 14-day period from the day the pass is issued  
(Flexible 5-day)  
\*The day the pass is issued is the day it is exchanged (when purchased outside of Japan)  
or sold (when purchased in Japan)
- ◇Sales locations        In Japan: Sold at sales offices in Japan  
Outside of Japan: Purchase an exchange ticket at a tour company or travel agency outside  
of Japan, and then exchange it at an exchange location in Japan
- ◇Prices                   Purchased outside of Japan:  
Adults (ages 12 and up) **¥19,000**, children (ages 6 to 11) **¥9,500**  
Purchased in Japan:  
Adults (ages 12 and up) **¥20,000**, children (ages 6 to 11) **¥10,000**
- ◇Validity                Unlimited use of ordinary car reserved seating on limited express trains (Shinkansen  
included), express trains, and local trains on the JR Hokkaido lines, JR EAST lines (BRT  
included), the whole Aomori Railway line, the whole Iwate Galaxy Railway line, and the  
whole Sendai Airport Transit line, within the free usage area.
- ◇Eligibility             Foreign nationals who are holders of non-Japanese passports (who have entered Japan with  
a “Temporary Visitor” visa to stay in Japan for no longer than 90 days) are eligible.  
Passports are required for confirmation purposes at the time of exchange or purchase.

Tour companies and travel agencies outside of Japan selling products aimed at overseas visitors to Japan, such as  
the Japan Rail Pass

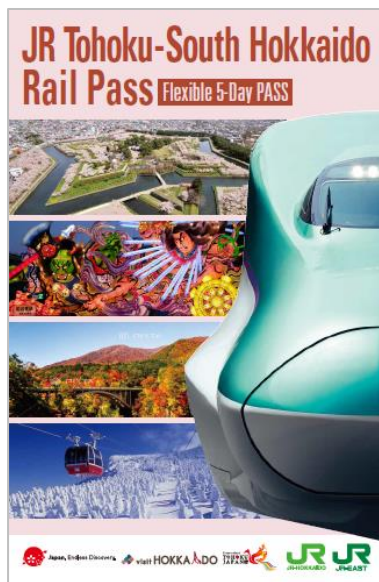
