Ticket design

Let's collect many local platform tickets for the memory of your Hokkaido trip!



You can buy a local platform ticket at JR Ticket Counter (Midori-no-madoguchi) in the designated station, and convenience stores or public facilities etc. around the station if it's an unmanned designated station.

A picture of specialty and view of the town selected by local government is printed on the back of the ticket.

Recommended route

Day 1

New Chitose Airport — Sapporo — Otaru — Yoichi — Otaru

Day 2

Otaru — Kita-Hiroshima — Tomakomai — Noboribetsu or Tōya

Day 3

Noboribetsu or Tōya — Oshamambe — Shin-Hakodate-Hokuto — Hakodate

Day 4

Hakodate — Ōnumakōen — Minami-Chitose — New Chitose Airport
